3. Description of the training offered:

Trainees have the opportunity to become a Pharmacy Technician (PT). This training program at Caroline Center is a 15-week program inspired by the Sister at Notre Dame with a M-F 9am-3pm schedule for classroom and hands-on skills practice. Additionally, PT candidates work 120 hours (3 weeks) in practical internships in a retail pharmacy under the supervision of a pharmacist and are posted to the Maryland Board of Pharmacy. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates are encouraged to take the exam for national certification in pharmacy (CPhT).

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Be a Woman
- Be 20+ years old
- Have high-school diploma or GED®
- Reside in Baltimore City
- Have a clean background- (Individuals may not have guilty charges, pending trials, or PBJs less than three years).

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment as a Certified Pharmacy Technician (PT)?

Trainees who complete this program and obtain employment as a Pharmacy Technician can expect to earn an average wage of \$15.15 per hour.

8: How much do I have to pay for this program?

There is no cost to applicants. However, before individuals apply, they will need to cover costs associated with professional licensing fees—\$279.50 for PTs.
