3. Description of the training offered:

- **1. Maritime Transportation Distribution Logistics training** is a 3-week, classroom-based training on material handling, warehouse operations, port related operations. In-person training takes place Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for 15 days. Successful completers will have the opportunity for additional, no-cost, skill certification training and credentials provided by training and/or employer partners.
- **2. Commercial Transportation Career training** is a 3-week, classroom-based training in passenger and non-passenger commercial transport industry. The in-person is Monday-Thursday 6-9 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for 15 days. Successful completers will have the opportunity for additional, no-cost, skill certification training and credentials provided by training and/or employer partners.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

For the **Maritime Transportation Distribution Logistics** training, participants can earn their Transportation Worker Identification Card (TWIC card) which is issued by U.S. Department of Homeland Security, along with a Forklift Operation Skill certification.

For the **Commercial Transportation Careers training**, participants can earn their Department of Transportation (DOT card), along with a Commercial Learners Permit, as well as transition to Behind-the-Wheel training with a variety of employer partners and earn their CDL-B commercial driver's license.

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Maritime Transportation Distribution Logistics training:
 - o Be 18 years of age or older
 - Possess a high School Diploma or GED®
 - o Be Drug free
- Commercial Transportation Careers:
 - o Be 21 years of age or older
 - Possess a high school Diploma or GED®
 - o Be Drug free and have a clean background

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the transportation, logistics, or distribution field?

Trainees who complete the **Maritime Transportation Distribution and Logistics program** and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$15 per hour.

Trainees who complete the **Commercial Transportation Careers program** and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$18 per hour.
