Food Production Workers

The Production Worker will be required to keep a reasonable flow of meat products going through the processing machines while visually inspecting product and packaging, before it becomes a final product. Remove and catch deformities, imperfections, and any other quality control issue that may cause the product to be rejected.

- Required to lift, push, and pull products to maintain a reasonable flow of materials.
- Stuff, formulate and link products by hand using our traditional process which requires extensive attention to detail.
- Place finished product into pre-formed boxes for distribution to customer.
- Check temperature of product to ensure it has reached cool enough temperature required for packaging.

***Available shifts are: 1st shift starts at 6AM to the end of production.
(Minimum 8 hour shift)**

***2nd shift starts at 3:30PM to the end of production.
(Minimum 8 hour shift)**
