- Earned a median of \$9,451 in that year


They do not receive welfare for long periods of time

Typically, they are African American women with 1 or 2 young children

- ❖ 94% are female
- * 71% are African American
- * 33 years old, on average
- * 72% have 1 to 2 children
- 43% have a child under 3 years old
