- ❖ 41% worked in the year before receiving TCA
- Earned a median of \$3,028 in that year
- ❖ 53% worked in the year after leaving TCA
- Earned a median of \$6,962 in that year

They do not receive welfare for long periods of time


63% received assistance for 2 years or less in last 10 years

9% received assistance for more than 5 of the last 10 years

Typically, they are African American women with 1 or 2 young children

- ❖ 96% are female
- 92% are African American
- * 32 years old, on average
- * 72% have 1 to 2 children
- ❖ 47% have a child under 3 years old

Some have disabilities that are expected to last over 1 year
