

Profile of Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) Recipients



Many have recent work experience, but their earnings are low

- ❖ 53% worked in the year before receiving TCA
- Earned a median of \$4,460 in that year
- ❖ 62% worked in the year after leaving TCA
- Earned a median of \$7,711 in that year

They do not receive welfare for long periods of time


64% received assistance for 2 years or less in last 10 years

9% received assistance for more than 5 of the last 10 years

Typically, they are Caucasian women with 1 or 2 young children

- ❖ 93% are female
- 62% are Caucasian
- 33 years old, on average
- * 71% have 1 to 2 children
- ❖ 42% have a child under 3 years old

Some have disabilities that are expected to last over 1 year

Most data is based on analysis of 633 adult payees who were recipients of TCA benefits in October 2014. Employment and earnings data is based on work-eligible recipients in federal fiscal 2014 and includes only formal employment in Maryland.
