Quorum Announced and Meeting Called to Order

B. NAIL TECHNICIAN APPRENTICE RESTART- ZIA BOWEN

B. PDF LICENSE

C. LICENSING REPORT

Ms. Fletcher further advised that the Board currently has 15 outstanding inspections and 57 inspections have been assigned for the month of October.
