Certificate of Insurance

Home Inspectors are required to have General Liability Insurance in the amount of not less than \$150,000.

*Your name (not a company name) must be printed on the certificate as an insured party or in the description field on the certificate. A company name may also be present on the certificate.

Your certificate of insurance must indicate a policy effective date and policy expiration date.

The Commission of Real Estate Appraisers and Home Inspectors must be named as the certificate holder on your certificate of insurance, obligating your insurer to notify the Commission in the event your insurance is cancelled.

The certificate holder should be:
